Excellent red fall color late in the season and lasting 3-4 weeks. Full sun, 50' tall, 40' spread, average water, well drained soils.

Oval rounded head with orange-red fall color. Rapid growth. Full sun, 50' tall, 40' spread, average water, well drained soils.						
<b>ACER palmatum</b>	<b>Bloodgood</b>	\$55.00				
Broad-rounded habit. Branches often layered or sweeping toward the ground in weeping cultivars. Narrowly lobed leaves are often dissected creating a lacy appearance. Good red purple color through the season. Upright rounded habit. sun/part sun, height: 20.0 ft, width: 20.0 ft, water: average, well drained soils.

New growth and fall color is crimson red. Handsome cascading branches. Sun/part sun, height: 10.0 ft, width: 12.0 ft, water: average, well drained soils .

Pyramidal oval tree. Exfoliating bark which exposes the brown under layer. Medium to fast grower. Full sun, 70' tall, 50' spread, average to heavy water, well drained or wet soils.

Deciduous reddish purple flowers in early spring before the heart shaped leaves. Medium grower. Weeping form producing an umbrella-shaped crown. Reddish purple flowers. Sun/part sun; 6' tall; 8' spread; average water and growth rate; reddish purple flower.

Large deciduous shrub tree with open spreading growth. Panicles of fleecy white blooms as foliage is emerging. Sun/part sun, 20' tall, 15' spread, average to heavy water, well drained or wet soils.						
<b>CORNUS KOUSA</b>	<b>Satomi' Dogwood</b>		\$29.99			
Pink flower bracts vary in color intensity dependent on geographical conditions. Sun/part sun, 25' tall, 25' spread, average to heavy water, well drained or wet soils.						
florida	<b>White Dogwood</b>	\$12.99				
An excellent landscape choice in all four seasons. Flowers are showy in spring. Leaves turn red-purple in fall. Glossy red fruits attract winter songbirds. Likes partial shade; moist, acid, well-drained soil. Grows to 25', 25' spread.						
	<b>Weeping Dogwood</b>	\$19.99				
Unusual dogwood with large white flowers on weeping branches in spring. Narrow tree with branches reaching toward the ground. Green leaves turning purple in fall. Wonderful focal point. Slow growing. Height 12'.

Dense pyramidal tree with dark green glossy foliage often with a brown pubescent back. Creamy white 8-12" fragrant flowers in May. Leaves smaller than the species and backed with brown pubescence. Creamy white fragrant flowers. Sun; 30' tall; 15' spread; average water and growth rate; well drained soils, white flowers.
